20 Plants for Under Trees

It 's hard to establish large plants among the roots of existing trees. Use plants in small pots, and help new plants with their own supply of water-saving crystals or compost.

Viola	hederacea	"Native Violet"	GC	white and purple flowers most of the year
Westringia	fruticosa	"Native Rosemary"	MS	white or mauve flowers for much of the year
